Scottish Under-23 honours while with Dunfermline Athletic. He was signed by Villa in October 1962. Before moving to outside-right last week, Fraser had made four League appearances at right-back this season.

Phil Woosnam's two goals last week were his first of the season, for he had drawn a blank in 14 previous League games divided between the two inside-forward berths. A Welsh international as amateur and professional, Woosnam was with Leyton Orient and West Ham before joining Villa in November 1962.

Ever-Present Hateley

Nottingham-born Tony Hateley (22) was signed from Notts County last close-season as a replacement when Irish international Derek Dougan went to Peterborough. Hateley has done well in the First Division, is the last ever-present in Villa's front line, and also their leading marksman with 13 League goals.

Mike Tindall, normally a wing-half, has shown his versatility recently by turning out on the left wing and in his present berth at inside-left. A native of Birmingham, Tindall is a product of Villa's ground staff and a former England Youth international. He signed professional in April 1958.

Outside-left Harry Burrows has the distinction of having topped Villa's scoring list in each of the past two seasons. He has also been finding the net well this winter, having eleven goals to his credit in 24 League games. A native of Haydock, near Wigan, Burrows joined Villa from school and signed professional in March 1957. An England Under-23 international, he was originally an inside-forward, moving to the left wing after the transfer of Peter McParland to Wolves two years ago.
